## WGNSW Medals

Entry Fee must be paid prior to the commencement of the first medal round.
6 Rounds x 18 Holes Stroke - 3 Divisions: Divisions: as set by committee
The Winner in each Division, 3 Lowest Nett Aggregate Scores
The winners are eligible to play for WGI Trophy on finals day.
Also eligible to play for WGNSW Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals in November.
NB: Changes to Handicap: Once a player has commenced in her relevant division, she remains in that division for the duration of the 6 rounds. All scores returned, irrespective of handicap changes, shall count for that original Medal Division.

Club Medals 9/6 Rounds x 18 Holes.
The first 6 Club Medals are played in conjunction with the WGNSW Medals and the last 3 Club Medals are to be played in club divisions, which are subject to change. In the rounds of the last 3 Club Medal players will have the option of playing a Single Stableford if they do not wish to play for the Club Medal.

In the event of tied scores in a medal round, the winner will be decided by a play off in the next scheduled stroke round.

The winner of the monthly medal is also eligible to win the daily event.
Eclectic - Winners and Runners Up in 3 Divisions. In an event of a tie joint winners will be declared.

## Most Reduced Handicap

18 Hole Point Score - Winner in 3 divisions. In the event of a tie the player who has played the most rounds in the season will be declared the winner.

Fay Foxton Trophy - Single Match Play Knock Out. Trophy by Club.
Marj \& Wally Thompson Memorial Trophy, Stroke - Best Individual nett over three rounds. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by a countback.

The Players Trophy - Aggregate of best 6 net scores recorded in stroke rounds. In the event of a tie joint winners will be declared. Trophy by Val Kotlash.

Gobblers - Most gobblers recorded on Women's Individual Competition Days. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by a countback. Trophy donated by Deb Weeks.

WGI Trophy - in conjunction with WGNSW Medal Round, played in July.
WGNSW Mabel McKenzie Brooch - Open to Veteran players only, played in 3 Divisions.

Divisions TBA. Played in April/ May. Best nett score in each division.
Super Vet - Played in Conjunction, open to veteran's over 65 years of age,
Handicaps 0-45. Best nett score to be the winner.
WGNSW Country Championship - Open to Veteran Players only. 18 Holes Stroke Event played in 3 Divisions, Best Nett in 3 Divisions. Played in May/June.

WGI Hartball Ambrose held annually
Medal of Medals - The Medal of Medals will be decided annually by a stroke round of18 Holes, all monthly medal winners throughout the season are eligible to compete. In the event of a tie joint winners will be declared. Trophy donated by Yvonne Ryan.

Annual Putting Competition - Winners in 3 divisions. Played in conjunction with ALL Medal Rounds.

Aggregate of best 5 rounds not including Medal of Medals round. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by a countback.

## NEW 2019 RULES

Players need to familiarise with the rule changes and apply them correctly.


#### Abstract

Two suggested Local Rules ie Playing 4 from point of exit for an Out of Bounds Ball and Maximum number of shots on a hole in Stroke Play are NOT being implemented in our club at this stage.


## Conditions of Play.

Players required for a competition other than WGNSW events.
A minimum of 6 players is required for a competition.
20 players required for two divisions.
31 players required for 3 divisions
Players must report to the starter at least 15 minutes before time to play.
All competitors must be at the tee ready to hit off by their allocated time. Failure to comply with this rule - Refer to Rule 5.3

Members should read the notice boards before commencing play. You are deemed to be aware of all conditions of play and local rules in force.

## Competition Cards must show correct handicap.

Any protests or disputes that are likely to affect the outcome of the competition must be made to the Match Committee or an appointed representative before the relevant competition is declared closed, i.e. before the results have been officially announced.

Slow Play: In the case of serious or repeated offences: rule 6-7 will be enforced, so please keep your rightful place in the field.

Divisions for Club Events will be decided before the commencement of the season's competitions. Divs are set by committee each year.

WGNSW Medals and Club Medals will be decided by a play off in the next stroke round.

Championship Gross in all divisions will be decided by a three holes play off, if still tied then sudden death, to be played after the final round.

Count Back- best net over the last 9 holes, if still tied best net score over the last 6 holes, if still tied best net score over the last 3 holes, if still tied best net hole by hole from the $18^{\text {th }}$

## Eclectic, Gobblers \& Point Score.

Played in conjunction with all women's Single events on Women's Competition Days
Season: First Medal round to the Medal of Medals.
Eclectic: Half player's handicap at the beginning of the last round of competition will be used to determine the winner in each division.

Open and Charity Days- payment of entry fee to be paid prior to the event.
Motorized Transport: There will be no restrictions regarding the use of motorized transport.
